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in gary brockwell s debut novel eddie dungiven children s entertainer and close hand magician is bored with his life and of his wife sally s preoccupation

with cleaning and taking part in flawed get rich quick schemes his only respite from this marital entrapment comes in the form of regular forays to a secluded beach with his collie spaniel cross henry that is until one day when a chance encounter with a beautiful stranger named cerys sindon changes everything as sally s behaviour becomes increasingly erratic and causes her relationship with her husband to deteriorate eddie prepares to embark on the ultimate betrayal with the captivating cerys but the sudden death of his father figure and the sentiments of his good friend focus eddie s attention on a revaluation of what is central to his life and what will make him happy in his desperate search for answers eddie is drawn into the world of the medium ignatius mckenzie and the personal revelations he presents which have far reaching implications for both eddie and cerys and a dark secret that she conceals inspired by the work of john irving and colin bateman chasing the sun with henry explores the effect of tragedy and change on a relationship gary s thought provoking novel will appeal to readers that enjoy contemporary fiction especially those that are interested in relationships and the various guises of love

antonia fraser s bestselling biography of henry viii s six wives a subject of enduring fascination the six wives of henry viii catherine of aragon anne boleyne jane seymour anna of cleves katherine howard and catherine parr have become defined in a popular sense not so much by their lives as by the way these lives ended but as antonia fraser conclusively proves they were rich and feisty characters they may have been victims of henry s obsession with a male heir but they were not willing victims on the contrary they displayed considerable strength and intelligence at a time when their sex supposedly possessed little of either

it is perhaps a matter rather for regret than for surprise that so few attempts have been made to describe as a whole the life and character of henry viii no ruler has left a deeper impress on the history of his country or done work which has been the subject of more keen and lasting contention courts of law are still debating the intention of statutes the tenor of which he dictated and the moral political and religious are as much in dispute as the legal results of his reign he is still the great erastian the protagonist of laity against clergy his policy is inextricably interwoven with the high and eternal dilemma of church and state and it is well nigh impossible for one who feels keenly on these questions to treat the reign of henry viii in a reasonably judicial spirit no period illustrates more vividly the contradiction between morals and politics in our desire to reprobate the immorality of henry s methods we are led to deny their success or in our appreciation of the greatness of the ends he achieved we seek to excuse the means he took to achieve them as with his policy so with his character there was nothing commonplace about him his good and his bad qualities alike were exceptional it is easy by suppressing the one or the other to paint him a hero or a villain he lends himself readily to polemic but to depict his character in all its varied aspects extenuating nothing nor setting down aught in malice is a task of no little difficulty
