originally published in 1948 and reprinted in 1955 and updated in 1961 this book is a straightforward account of moral philosophy for students it discusses comprehensively the contributions made by 20th century moralists both in terms of the interpretation of their predecessors and original ethical speculation

as the perfect companion to introduction to ethics courses dell olivo and simon s reader includes the most influential ethical theories without overwhelming the beginning student it contains a variety of readings encompassing contemporary and classic philosophers male and female perspectives of both western and non western ethical traditions and readings in both theoretical and applied ethics introduction to ethics comprises of thirty seven essays divided into nine chapters the first chapter introduces the nature of moral theory with a brief account of the different moral theories that will follow in the text chapters 2 through 8 are each devoted to a particular moral theory with readings that represent the position and those who challenge it accompanied by an application of the theory to a particular moral problem finally chapter 9 offers readings in practical guidance on living a good life each chapter has a brief introduction that provides an overview of the selection with pointers on what to note as the selection is read and concludes with a series of thought provoking study questions and a selection for further

what it is its problems approaches and methods b an introductory goal it helps the reader to gain a better grasp of the complex and multifarious nature of the various concepts and phenomena related to computer ethics c an analytic goal it answers several key theoretical questions of great philosophical interest arising from the investigation of the ethical implications of ICTs although entirely independent of the philosophy of information oup 2011 floridi's previous book the ethics of information complements it as new work on the foundations of the philosophy of information
